SUMMARY: The Eminent Speaker will provide instruction of Hoocąk language instruction to learners of various proficiencies in an effort to revitalize the Hoocąk language as a instructor and mentor. The Eminent Speaker is a first language speaker who will provide a service as a resource to the communities, and staff in accomplishing the goals and objectives of the Hoocąk Language Division.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Assist with the development of all first and second language acquisition programs.
- 2. Share language experiences in both academic and community settings.
- 3. Technological recordings will be required for the preservation of Language and Culture.
- 4. Assist in teaching community classes, with participants ranging from preschool, children, teen, adults, elders and families.
- 5. Assist in teaching formal classes in high school, college, or immersion settings.
- 6. Provide effective instruction incorporating various teaching methodologies including fluent communicative techniques.
- 7. Appropriately incorporate Hoocak culture within program activities.
- 8. Collaborate with Language Division staff in planning, development and implementation of community classes, activities and events.
- 9. Utilize public speaking abilities to present workshops and other trainings.
- Ability to work flexible schedule to accommodate evening classes and occasional weekend events.
- 11. Other duties as assigned within the scope of the LAP and Hoocak Academy goals and objectives by Eminent Speaker Liaison.

REQUIRED SKILLS & ABILITIES:

- 1. Individual should possess the following:
 - a. show understanding, respect and value of Hoocak culture;
 - b. establish good rapport with elders, youth and community;
 - c. possess positive and outgoing interpersonal skills;
 - d. Basic computer skills.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: (REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE & EXPERIENCE)

- 1. First Language Speaker.
- 2. The following are preferred but not required: valid driver's license, insurance, and reliable transportation.
- 3. Individual must be able to pass a criminal background investigation according to State Licensing requirements.
