SUMMARY: Responsible for the food and beverage needs of the facility which ultimately enhances every interaction for our guests and employees; customer service is our top priority for both internal and external guests.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Responsible for the proper and profitable function of all phases of the Food and Beverage operation. Working closely with the Assistant General Manager and Purchasing Department.
- 2. Responsible for the development of Services procedures and their update. Provides constant on the job training through individual outlets, managers or himself.
- 3. Promotes positive public relations and employee relations. Must maintain confidentiality.
- 4. Maintain and enforce health standards.
- 5. Anticipates volume of business by carefully keeping informed of up coming activities in the community and Holiday events.
- 6. Make provisions to cope with staffing adequately and economically. Encourages promising employees in order that they receive management training.
- 7. Knows internal controls, policies and procedures.
- 8. Supervises Executive Chef, Restaurant/Beverage Services Manager, and Restaurant Services Manager.
- 9. Knowledge of State and Federal regulations regarding Safe and Public Environment Standard.
