POSITION OVERVIEW

A Dishwasher is responsible for cleaning dishes in a food service environment to ensure that the kitchen has a steady supply of clean plates, bowls, silverware, pots, pans, and glasses. They are also responsible for maintaining a clean, safe work area, which ultimately enhances every interaction for our guests and employees, customer service, is our top priority for both internal and external guests.

PERFORMANCE-BASED JOB FUNCTIONS AND OBJECTIVES

- 1. Scrape and sort dishes before loading them into a dishwashing machine for cleaning.
- 2. Monitor dishwasher machine's water temperature daily during sanitary wash cycle
- 3. Unload dishwashing machine after wash cycle and put utensils and dishes in the proper storage area.
- 4. Sweep and scrub kitchen floors to ensure a clean and tidy work area.
- 5. Empty kitchen trash and dispose of bags in proper garbage receptacle.
- 6. Perform other duties as assigned.
