**POSITION: OPTOMETRY TECHNICIAN**

**SUMMARY:** Assist the optometrist in providing patient care and managing the optical dispensary including ordering, adjusting, and repairing patient eyewear.

#### **DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- 1. Responsible for ordering and maintaining an inventory of optometry supplies.
- 2. Performs screening tests on patients as requested by optometrist.
- 3. Selecting, measuring, and ordering eyewear.
- 4. Accepts payment for eyewear and contact lenses from patients.
- 5. Scheduling appointments, patient registration, maintaining patient records.
- 6. Perform minor eyeglass repairs and adjustments for patients.
- 7. Perform other duties as assigned by supervisor.

### **REQUIRED SKILLS & ABILITIES:**

- 1. Ability to operate and use lensometer, visual field analyzer, fundus camera, tonometer, pupilometer, and autokeratometer.
- 2. Ability to operate standard office equipment including computer, copy machine, calculator, and fax machine.
- 3. Possess excellent oral and written communication and telephone skills.
- 4. Ability to plan, organize, set priorities, and work independently is required.
- 5. Must maintain patient confidentiality in accordance with Department policy, Privacy Act, and HIPAA regulations.

#### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: (REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE & EXPERIENCE)

- 1. High School diploma or equivalent.
- 2. Must be highly motivated individual willing to be trained as an optometry technician.
- 3. Must obtain CPR certification within six months of employment.
- 4. Possess knowledge of operation of optometry clinic.
- 5. Must live and promote a healthy, non-abusive lifestyle.
- 6. Valid driver's license, dependable transportation and proper insurance.

**WORKING CONDITIONS:** Optometry clinic is an office setting located in a multi-disciplinary health care facility providing eye and vision care to members and employees of the Ho-Chunk Nation.
