SUMMARY: The Games Dealer must interact with and maintain an entertaining atmosphere for the players, while not giving up game security and pace of the game.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Maintain security and integrity of the game including cards, chips, dice and equipment.
2. Conducts the playing of the game including the exchanging of chips for cash, deals cards and collects and pays wagers.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: (REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE & EXPERIENCE)

- 1. Must have high school diploma or equivalent.
2. Must have successfully completed a recognized dealer training school with proficiency in math.
