POSITION OVERVIEW

Responsible for installing and maintaining electrical systems, which ultimately enhances every interaction for our guests and employees; customer service is our top priority for both internal and external guests.

PERFORMANCE-BASED JOB FUNCTIONS AND OBJECTIVES

- 1. Install and maintain electrical systems up to 110-220-440 volts daily.
- 2. Work with blueprints, must comply with state and local codes monthly.
- 3. Work with conduit, electrical boxes for switches and outlets and junctions, pull wire or cable through conduit, and connect to circuit breakers, transformers and other components daily.
- 4. Join wire and cover with connectors (use solder gun) daily.
- 5. Install coaxial or fiber optic cables that are electrical related daily, weekly, and monthly.
- 6. Install telephone-computer wiring and equipment, connect motors to electrical power daily for new equipment.
- 7. Rewire and replace fuse boxes with circuit breakers, repair motors, transformers and generators daily/monthly and during annual maintenance.
- 8. Provide most preventative maintenance repairs such as circuit breakers, fuses, switches, and install new electrical equipment daily as it arrives to the facility.
- 9. Drill holes, set anchors, measure, bend and install conduit on a daily basis.
- 10. Install, connect and test wiring, outlets and switches as defined in a preventative maintenance program every 3 months.
- 11. Set up and draw diagrams for electrical systems; work with schematics daily.
- 12. Work at all level of heights daily.
- 13. Change ballasts on a weekly basis.
- 14. Perform other duties as assigned within the scope of this job description.
